MAYA COLLECTION


By combining Aztec and Mayan graphic fabric patterns and architectural motifs with a 1950's colour pallette, Esther Patterson, founder of Curiousa, designed and made the Maya Collection; a marrying of hand-made bone china and free-blown glass. The development of the ceramic components was through a creative and organic process, from clay on the wheel to slip-casting before being complimented with our UK made, free-blown glass shades. The clay elements are all created in Curiousa's in-house studio, nestled within the historic 18th Century Haarlem cotton mill in Wirksworth, Derbyshire. The bone-china is self glazing, demonstrating Curiousa's commitment to sustainability, only needing firing the once, significantly reducing the collection's ecological footprint without compromising on quality.



CLASSIC GLASS PENDANTS

Our Classic Pendant range can be blown to order as Small, Medium or Large.

When glass is free hand-blown the colour will naturally vary depending on the shape and thickness of the piece. We embrace imperfections within the glass such as bubbles, swirls, variations in shape, colour and size as they are part of the hand crafted process.
















A spiral of LED's housed within a diffused tubular suspension, intersected with natural or white wooden disks.







IS A CURIOUSA FREE BLOWN LIGHT RIGHT FOR YOU?

What is hand-blown & free-blown glass?

Although both are traditional methods of blowing glass by hand, there is actually quite a big difference between them. Most commercial hand-blown glass is blown into moulds, this allows many more pieces to be made at a time and each will be, more or less, identical to one another.

Free-blown glass however is shaped purely by hand, without the use of any moulds. The glass blower must stretch and manipulate the molten glass into the required form, using tools and gauges, whilst maintaining the temperature by repeatedly returning the piece to the furnace. It's a much slower process and relies totally on the skill and experience of the glass blower.

But the end result is a piece of glass that is like no other, it will be truly, totally unique.

What to expect from your Curiousa light

As no two pieces of our glass are the same, it follows every piece has some variation. It may be a difference in size or colour, or because we use some recycled glass, there may be small bubbles, marks or swirls - but we believe these differences should be celebrated and cherished.

A shade blown by Allister in Stourbridge may look slightly different to the same shade blown by Jonathan in Derbyshire. We think it's amazing that each piece has the mark and personality of their maker, but of course it's not right for everyone. If you are looking for perfection or for an identical matching pair, you may want to look elsewhere.

But, if like us you want to celebrate the individual charm of a truly hand-crafted light piece, one that you can enjoy for generations to come, then we'll look forward to hearing from you.

SHAPE & SIZE VARIANCE

We work with our glass blowers to a 10% size tolerance from the original design. For matching sets there may be a 5% to 10% size difference between each shade.

VARIATIONS IN COLOUR

Coloured glass is applied whilst molten to the inside of the shade, so there will be some variation in density of colour between shades or sometimes within a single piece of glass.

SEMI OPAQUES

Our semi-opaque glass can show marbling and banding and small tooling marks can sometimes be seen on the rim.

BUBBLES & SWIRLS

To form the required shape, the glass blower must continuously roll the molten glass backwards and forwards. This can often leave slight swirls or bubbles visible within the glass and are all part of the making process.

Diffuse colours are created by sand-blasting the transparent glass to create a diffused effect. These colours are only a guide, exact finish may vary.

FITTINGS



Our ceiling roses and light fittings are available in a choice of 5 finishes. A powder coat finish in White or a bespoke colour is also available for ceiling plates with an additional supplementary cost.

FLEX

The fabric twisted flex is stocked in ten colours.
Round flex and additional colours are also available.

All pendants are supplied with 1m of adjustable flex but can be specified to any length.



NB. American and bathroom lights are supplied with round flex (non-twisted).



BATHROOM LIGHTING

Wall Lights, and many of our single Pendants, Chandeliers and Sculptural Stacks, can now be made to IP Rating for bathrooms, meaning they can be used in wet areas, near sinks and showers (Zones 1 & 2) and are fully compliant with BSEN 60598-1(2015).

Note: Our bathroom lights are not certified for North America.

Each light piece is made to measure using round, fabric covered flex (non twisted) or metal rods and feature an enclosed LED G9 bulb.
